WHAT ARE CEU's AND DO I NEED THEM? CEU's ARE NOT NEEDED TO RECEIVE CREDIT FROM YOUR STATE.

CEU's (Continuing Education Unit's) are designed for in-service programs for professionals and nonprofessionals who want to build and maintain a record of their achievement for participation in approved noncredit continuing educational programs. By attending this Seminar the CEU's you earn are not equivalent to academic credit. A permanent record of CEU's earned by you is maintained at UMass and an official transcript will be issued to whom you designate.

NEBOEA will no longer process filing for CEU's.

CEU Registration Forms will be available at the Registration Desk 1st floor Campus Center. If you wish to receive CEU's you are responsible for properly filling out, paying the fee and returning it to Continuing & Professional Education as instructed on the form.

ADDITIONAL IMPORTANT INFORMATION

(A) **WALK-IN REGISTRATION:** Because meal counts have to be guaranteed in advance, registration options which include meals may not be available to walk-in registrants. It is therefore best to pre-register by returning the enclosed form no later than September 19th. There is a \$35.00 late fee that will be imposed after this date. The “registration only” option will always be available.

(B) **LODGING:** Approximately 70 rooms at the Campus Center Hotel are on hold until September 2nd for seminar attendees. *However, the Hotel fills quickly so please make your reservations as soon as possible.* To accommodate more people, we encourage you to share a room with another attendee. The hotel provides one complimentary parking pass per room per day. If there is a second vehicle a pass may be purchased for \$5.00 per day. (C) **CANCELLATION:** Persons canceling before September 25 will receive a refund minus a \$35.00 cancellation fee. (Checks returned due to insufficient funds will be charged an additional \$35.00 fee.)
